Initial plan (aug 2008)

- Perl - userdata, log2results, queryengine
- HTML templates + XML config's

(we *didn't build this*)

Prototype (oct 2009)

- PHP + Zend Framework
- XML Configuration

Beta (march 2009)

- Experiment: Stress (4k participants)
- PAL + memcached sessions
- Identity
- XML configuration (ie. no admin gui)

v1.0 (aug 2009)

- Experiments: Brain + Personality (400k)
- KV Store (replaced Identity + sessions)
- Experiments MySQL (replaced XML conf)

v2.0 (jan 2010)

- Experiment: Virtual Revolution (70k)
- Participants in MySQL (part replaced KV)

v3.0 (june 2010)

- Experiments: Personality v2 & Stress
- Invites & relationships (MySQL)
- Split /experiments from /labuk (pal)
- Data extraction revamp
- Tasks API (replaces PAL talking to KV directly)
- External Accessibility review

v4.0 (sept 2010)

- Experiments: Money & Risk (BBCI)
- Scaling (make TV deadlines a non-issue)
- Stability: monitoring, outage mode etc.
- GVL3
- Decide what next ...

Volumes (2010 → 2011)

- 450k participants → 2m
- 73m variables → 0.5bn
- peaks ~ few hundred writes p/sec
